ARTISTIC DESIGN RULES:

1. Flowers need not be raised by the exhibitor, you may borrow flowers from others. Plant materials declared to be noxious weeds or protected species may not be used.

2. Figurines and accessories permitted only if called for in the schedule. Vases may be used as part of any designs. Compositions are designs that tell a story by use of accessories. Miniature designs up to 4 inches total height.

3. You may enter only one of the three sections for designers.

Section A: Novice-anyone who has not received a blue design ribbon.

Section B: Amateur-anyone who has received a blue
