Entries Close: July 31, 2021

Entry Fee: \$10 per head (breeding and market animals)

***** Any Mower County youth 18 & under may enter up to 2 animals in the Open Sheep Show free of charge.**

Limit of two animals per lot. *Only 1 group lot per exhibitor.

Entry Time: Thursday 4pm

Judging: Thursday, 6 pm

Release: Thursday immediately following class placing. (Supreme Champions will be named for breeding sheep)

General Rules:

1. Pens will be assigned around the show arena. (based on the date entries are received in the fair office). No pens will be allowed to be used for tack and grooming gear, but areas outside of Crane will be available. EXHIBITORS MUST CLEAN UP AFTER THEMSELVES.
2. Bedding will not be provided.
3. Senior lamb September 1-December 2020
Junior lamb after January 1 2021
4. Market Lambs will split by weight and lot.
5. Judge or superintendent may split lots as necessary
